## Implementation in Action: Contributions of ASEAN Scientists and Scientific Organizations to the BWC Monday, 14 December 2015 13:00—15:00 Room XXIV

The impact of the discussions and decisions in Geneva ultimately depends on actions by governments and nongovernmental stakeholders around the world.
